



Youth Mentoring Agreement

As part of **Re:fresh**, the Ruislip Baptist Church mentoring program, this is an agreement between:

_____ (Mentor) and _____ (Mentee)

Mentoring at RBC is a means by which people will:

- Feel valued, supported and encouraged.
- Have the opportunity to journey through life with another person, building trust and provided with the opportunity to grow in their faith and to reach their full God-given potential.
- Be prayed for regularly.
- Be given the opportunity to be accountable for how they live for Christ.

For twelve months, we commit ourselves to walk together in a mentoring relationship subject to ongoing mutual consent and continuing parental consent.

As a mentee, I will...

- Work with my mentor to identify what I would like to achieve.
- Work to achieve my goals, with support from my mentor.
- Respond quickly to contact from my mentor.
- Always turn up for meetings on time, and, if I have to cancel a meeting, I will give my mentor as much notice as I can.
- Contact the Re:refresh coordinators or a youth leader if the mentoring relationship is not working.

As a mentor, I will...

- Pray for and meet regularly with the mentee.
- Listen carefully to bring affirmation, support and challenge informed by biblical insights.
- Work with the mentee to identify goals and actions needed to support their personal development.
- Be supportive of the mentee and agree clear and realistic goals.
- Explain to the mentee at the first meeting that the mentoring sessions are confidential unless it is considered that the young person has been harmed or is at risk of harm or they disclose that another child or young person is at risk of harm.
- Always turn up for meetings on time, and, if I have to cancel a meeting, I will give my mentee as much notice as I can.
- Attend appropriate training.
- Make initial contact to arrange the first meeting with the Mentee's parent/carer.
- Partner with the mentee's parent/carer to agree appropriate forms of communication.
- At the end of each session write a brief overview of the meeting, to include the time, date and location of the meeting and email this to the Re:refresh coordinators.
- Contact the Re:refresh coordinators if the mentoring relationship not working out as planned.
